THE TRAP OF FALSE HUMILITY

Core Truth: True humility is not feeling small or inadequate; it is abiding in His presence without self-absorption.

Adam and Eve fell because they **felt inadequate** and tried to make themselves into who they should be. The Lord speaks:

“You must look to **My adequacy**, not your **inadequacy**. When you look at **yourself**, you turn from the truth in Me to the **deception** in your fallen nature.”

THE DANGER OF SILENCE AND RUNNING



Lot's Warning:

Through. Being “**different**” is not enough. **Righteousness** must be spoken to warn the wicked. “I was silent, and many **perished**.”

Jonah's Warning: You cannot **run** from the **presence** of the Lord. The church is running to ‘**Tarshish**’—trading with the **world**—when it should be running to the **Throne**.

The Issue: Mercy triumphs over judgment, but only when truth is spoken.



Living in the Reality of 'I AM'

The Identity:

He is not "**I WAS**" or "**I WILL BE.**" He is "**I AM.**" To know Wisdom is to know His timing.

The Error:

Those who live in the **past** or the future miss the reality of His presence *now*.

The Wisdom:

"Obedience in the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom, but the fullness of wisdom is to obey because of love."

THE PRISON OF DELUSION

- **The Condition:** The prisoners do not know they are in prison. They are **self-segregated** and **blind to the fences**.
- **The Materials:** The fences are made of **“Delusions.”** The massive walls are made of **“Fear.”**
- **The Leadership:** The guards (religious and secular leaders) are blinded by their own positions and insecurity. They attack anyone who questions their reality. **Discouragement blinds.**





The Escape: Faith and Vision

- **Principle:** “You can always go as far as you can see.” The fences of delusion crumble at the touch of faith, but the **Wall of Fear** must be climbed.
- **The Key:** The strength to climb comes from knowing the **Lord’s true name**—not just as a word, but as a Person.
- **Insight:** **Vision and faith** must work together; impatience is simply a lack of faith.

FALSE WISDOM VS. THE PATH OF DISCIPLINE

- **The Conflict:** The enemy appears as an angel of light offering “easy” wisdom. False wisdom appeals to the pride of knowing.
- **The Necessity:** True freedom often looks like bondage at first (Discipline), while bondage looks like freedom.
“If you do not use your vision by walking in what you see, you will lose it.”



The Three Armies



3. The Mob: Drifting, quarrelsome, destroying what the first group restored. The Lord will not lead a mob; they must be disciplined or dispersed.

2. The Middle:
Ambitious, distracted by rank, leaving the earth muddy.


1. The Vanguard:
Selfless, disciplined, restoring the earth. Marching in unity.



The Wisdom of Zipporah: Circumcision of the Heart

- **The Event:** God sought to kill Moses because he had not circumcised his son. **Judgment begins in the house of the Lord.**
- **The Lesson:** **Carnality** in the camp cannot be tolerated in the last days. The “flesh” (carnal nature) must **be cut away** for the army to survive the presence of the **Captain of the Host.**

The Glorious City



Structure: You cannot reach the **Highway of Truth** without walking the **Street of Love**. The city is built in the **hearts of men**.

Goal: The **Army** fights, but the **City** is the goal. The world will marvel at the **wisdom** of the City even more than the power of the **Army**.

Living Between the Living and the Dead

- **The Mission:** The builders are warriors who fight for the poor and oppressed. They survey the land to build structures that fit God's design, not man's.
- **The Courage:** “This is where you must live.” They live on the edge of hell to pull people into the valley of life. **Love is the source of courage.**



The Manna and Living Epistles



- **Definition:** Manna is the ‘fresh word’ God speaks daily, often through His people (Living Epistles). Scripture is the blueprint; Manna is the daily bread.
- **Instruction:** ‘You shall not see Me until you say, “Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!”’ We must discern the Lord’s voice in one another to survive the darkness.



The Power of Worship in Trial

- **Insight:** Worship in the midst of trials touches the Father more than the worship of heaven. Jesus went to the cross to give the Father **this joy**.
- **Command:** “Do not waste your trials—worship Him through them.” The joy of the Lord is your strength.



The Cloak of Humility

- **The Warning:** When the cloak is removed to show off the armor (spiritual pride), spiritual blindness ensues immediately. “You can see nothing here without wearing that cloak.”
- **The Restoration:** True authority is safely held only in **deep brokenness**. “If you will openly talk more about your **failures**... I will be able to more openly display your **victories**.”



The Ultimate Destiny: The House of the Lord

- **Final Truth:** “This is the door to My house.” We cannot see the House until we see the Lord in His people.
- **Takeaway:** The destination is not just power or glory, but serving in His house forever.
